4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	AN ORDINANCE introduced by the Public Infrastructure Committee consisting of David Banks, Sylvia Ortiz and Neil Dobler, confirming the Agreement of the Governing Body with the Marney Properties L.L.C. and the City of Topeka to abate City special assessments penalties to certain property in Lauren's Bay Estates when the property taxes and special assessments are paid in full.
12	WHEREAS, Marney Properties L.L.C. (hereinafter referred to as "Marney") owns
13	certain property in Lauren's Bay Estates in which it intends to develop for single-family
14	dwellings; and
15	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka (hereinafter referred to as "City") is a
16	governmental entity in which it collects property taxes within the City and special
17	assessments for improvements.
18	WHEREAS, the parcels of land Marney owns are legally described as:
19 20 21	Lot 19, Block B, Lauren's Bay Estates Subdivision, Shawnee County, Kansas Lot 16, Block B, Lauren's Bay Estates Subdivision, Shawnee County, Kansas Lot 06, Block E, Lauren's Bay Estates Subdivision, Shawnee County, Kansas
22	(hereinafter referred to as the "Marney Parcels"); and
23	WHEREAS, the Marney Parcels are subject to unpaid property taxes, special
24	assessments and penalties; and
25	WHEREAS, Marney wishes to develop single family dwellings on the Marney
26	Parcels and is willing the pay the unpaid property taxes and special assessments in
27	exchange for the special assessment penalties being waived; and
28	WHEREAS, the City encourages development of vacant property and agrees to
29	abate the special assessment penalties on the Marney Parcels in return for full payment
30	of the unpaid property taxes and special assessments.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. The Governing Body hereby declares its intent to abate all of the penalties on special assessments against the Marney Parcels to promote development of vacant property within the City in exchange for payment of unpaid property taxes and special assessments attached to the Marney Parcels.

Section 2. Upon payment of unpaid property taxes and special assessments, the penalties relating to the special assessments attached to the Marney Parcels are hereby abated.

<u>Section 3.</u> The abatement only pertains to penalties assessed to delinquent special assessments.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to deliver a copy of this Ordinance, upon its effective date, to the Shawnee County Treasurer with directions to remove the penalties for special assessments currently showing on the tax rolls for the Marney Parcels upon payment in full of the unpaid property taxes and special assessments.

Section 5. The City Clerk is also directed to deliver a copy of this Ordinance to the Register of Deeds of Shawnee County, Kansas for recording.

<u>Section 6</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.

<u>Section 7</u>. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules, or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 8. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
